| Exposition <i>Background information that would be helpful for the reader. Where is this person from? What are they like? How are they related to you? etc...</i> | |
| Initial Incident <i>This is the first evidence that there is a conflict or problem. It could be an internal conflict or maybe something happened to them. Whatever it is, it is the event or feeling that initiates their journey or story</i> | |
| Rising Action <i>Which events build up to the climax of the story?</i> | |
| Climax <i>This is the point of the story when everything changes. The main character (i.e., your family member) realizes something new, is changed significantly, or some kind of external action happens.</i> | |
| Falling Action <i>What happens after the climax of the story? How does your family member carry on with their life after this?</i> | |
| Resolution <i>Consider the Initial Incident. How is this finally put to rest or resolved?</i> | |
| Denouement <i>You, as the writer, should reflect on this story. What does all of this mean for you as a teenager in 2020?</i> | |
