The following sentence is from a Gurung text.

- (1) tjjorti-ri pudza læ-ba-ri læmæ tso-mo  
stone.temple-LOC prayer do-NMLZR-LOC lama put-NPST  
They employ lamas to worship in the temple.

Can you find out the following:

**(i) Is it possible to switch the order of the two locative NPs? Can you say:**

pudza læ-ba-ri tjjorti-ri læmæ tso-mo

**(ii) If so, what does it mean?**

**(iii) Can you leave out the second locative NP? Can you say:**

tjjorti-ri læmæ tso-mo

**(iv) If so, what does it mean?**

**(iii) Can you leave out the first locative NP? Can you say:**

pudza læ-ba-ri læmæ tso-mo

**(iv) If so, what does it mean?**

**(v) Is it possible to change the activity of the lamas? Can you say:**

'They employ lamas to read scriptures in the temple.'

'They employ lamas to play music in the temple.'

**(vi) Is it possible to change other elements in the sentence? Can you say:**

'They employ women to make food in the temple.'

'They employ men to do agriculture in the fields.'
